

Miss Oatmeal Festival Pageant

Friday, September 1, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.

Miss Little Bit of Oatmeal-Must be 4 years old but not more than 6 years old

Miss Oatmeal Muffin-Must be 7 years old but not more than 9 years old

Miss Oatmeal Cookie- Must be 10 years old but not more than 11 years old

Miss Oatmeal Princess- Must be 12 years old but not more than 13 years old

Miss Oatmeal Queen- Must be 14 years old but not more than 18 years old and must still be enrolled in high school

Eligible contestants must attend in the Burnet Consolidated Independent School District. 1st place pageant winners from last year are not qualified to compete in the same category this year. If they are age eligible to move up to the next category, they may compete for that crown. This will eliminate contestants from winning the same title two years in a row. Contestants must be of high moral character. A contestant will be disqualified due to academic/behavioral problems, pregnancy, marriage, pending criminal charges or past criminal records.

Each girl must be sponsored by a civic club, business, organization, or individual. A fee of \$30.00 must accompany the application at the time it is returned to the pageant directors-make checks payable to OATMEAL COMMUNITY ASSOC.

You may go as formal or as casual as you like, but keep in mind that the judges will be judging according to age appropriateness.

Each contestant must furnish a photo of their choice for the "Most Photogenic" portion of the competition. Photos must be 4"X6" or smaller. Photos larger than "4X6" will not be accepted.

Orientation/sign up: Wednesday, August 16th at 6:30 p.m. at the Oatmeal Community Center. Entries will be due. We will go over pageant rules and address any questions or concerns. You will need to turn in your photo for the "Most Photogenic" competition and Pageant Profile.
